Carlisle River Primary School aims to guide our students to become successful learners, confident and creative individuals and active responsible citizens. Our curriculum is guided by the Victorian Curriculum and comprises; The Arts, English, Mathematics, Humanities, Science, Health and Physical Education and Technology. Specialist teachers conduct Art, Library and Creative writing. Enrichment is provided through programs including; Reading Assistance, Human Development, Concert, Bike Ed, Swimming, Camping, Indonesian language, Group days. Water watch program and Interschool Sport.

All junior students' literacy learning is supported by the Sounds Write program, which is run from grade Prep to Grade3, which has assisted students to improve their NAPLAN results at Years 3.

Our students enjoy a technology rich learning environment using both iPads and Microsoft technology. Carlisle River Primary School is an E-Smart school.

Carlisle River Primary School has 8 students and 2.8 staff including a principal, early year's teacher and an educational support staff member.
